Business Manager Update, June 2025

If you haven't heard, the BLC Council approved a new part-time position called the Business Manager (about 10 hours per week). The position serves a variety of roles including preparation of monthly and annual financial reports for the Council, assistance with the preparation of the annual Mission Plan (budget), management of the CoRental agreement for our rentals and oversight of non-profit uses of our facilities, contract management as the need arises, liaison with DA Davidson for BLC's investment portfolio, and modernizing our record management system. I was hired into the position effective June 1st. I'll be providing monthly reports going forward (except for July).

Our finances remain healthy with general fund (GF) giving averaging almost \$26,000/month. Our mission plan estimated \$25k/month so we're a little ahead of anticipated giving, THANKS to all for their faithful gifts. Expenses are somewhat higher than last year however, and we are slowly eating into our monthly reserve fund as the year progresses. Our ending fund balance for May 31 was about \$37,800. May was only a 4 Sunday month, so we hope to catch up a little with June giving.

I'm pleased to report that we distributed our annual Mission Partner giving in May, with a total of \$30,000 distributed to 13 mission partners. \$11,000 came from the GF, and \$19,000 was provided from the Mission Endowment Trust fund. What a glorious way to carry out God's mission in our community!

In the past, we have given as many as 37 shawls. This year 30 shawls have gone to the camp. The camp is held at FLBC and they love the facilities.
